- If a Notification of Non-Compliant Appeal Brief was mailed or notified, the appeal brief can be filed 1 month from the mailing of the Notification of Non-Complaint Appeal Brief without incurring an extension of time fee (up to additional 5 months with appropriate fee for extensions of time).
- If the appeal brief is filed <u>with</u> a notice of appeal, the appeal brief can be filed 3 months from the mailing of the Last Action without incurring an extension of time fee (up to 6 months with appropriate extension of time fee).
